Developers and enthusiasts, this track is for you! Share your experiences with the Flood Modeller API - how you've customised, extended, or integrated it into your workflows. We're keen to learn about your innovative solutions.

Submission Deadline:

- Abstracts should be submitted in English, in PDF format, and must be between 150 to 300 words.
- Within the submission include your name, organisation, and email address (all excluded from word count)
- The submission deadline is 17:00 Hrs (BST) on Friday, May 3rd, 2024.

Review Process:

- The organising committee will review all submitted abstracts.
- Decision letters will be sent to presenters by Friday 7th June 2024.

Presentation Formats:

- Abstracts can be accepted for either poster presentations or oral (PowerPoint) presentations.

Registration and Agenda:

- Presenters (oral and poster) are required to register for the conference before 2nd September 2024.
- Failure to register by this date may result in forfeiture of the presenter's spot on the agenda.
- As a token of appreciation, presenters (oral and poster) will receive a 50% discount on the full registration fee.

Oral Presentation Submission:

- Presenters invited to give oral presentations must submit their PowerPoint presentations by 7th October 2024.

- Presenters will have 20 minutes to deliver their presentation and there will be additional time for Q&A.

Poster Presentation Submission:

- Presenters invited to give poster presentations must bring their own poster presentation on a pull-up banner (max size H2000mm x W1200mm) to the event.
- Presenters will have 5 minutes to deliver their presentation and there will be additional time for Q&A.
